Kinderhilfswerk Eine Welt (KHW) has been supporting children and young people in Africa, Asia, South America, and Europe since 1975, prioritizing education, health, and care. We currently focus on projects in Nepal and Mali.

It is important to us that our support and empowerment are sustainable and have lasting effects in the project area. For example, we build schools and health centers in remote regions where there would be no access to education and health care facilities otherwise. We place great emphasis on involving the respective community and cooperating with local partners. In addition, we ensure the greatest possible local value creation in order to strengthen the economy. This is why school desks are built by local carpenters and schoolbooks are procured in the project countries. Only if not possible otherwise we resort to foreign products, as is sometimes the case with medical equipment.

Through many years of cooperation with trusted local partners, we can guarantee an efficient, transparent, and rapid use of donations. Our local contacts have a lot of experience and know the needs and circumstances in the target areas very well.

This enables us to address highly relevant and sensitive socio-political issues in the project countries, such as the unequal treatment of girls or genital mutilation.

MALI

Mali is currently facing a profound political crisis. This makes it even more important for us to strengthen civil society and provide access to education. Our organization has been working in Mali since 1975 and has an excellent local network.

A school garden for Mana: The village is located 80 kilometers from Bamako. Our organization has expanded and renovated an elementary school here from 2022 to 2023. As many of the students are affected by food insecurity and malnutrition, a school garden will be installed on the grounds to grow vegetables, fruit, and pulses. In this way, the nutrition of the children and their families can be improved. In addition, the participants learn important strategies for adapting to climate change in workshops.

► **The school garden and climate project improves the food security of around 820 school children and their families and strengthens their resilience to climate change effects.**

NEPAL

KHW has been active in Nepal since 2004 and has successfully implemented 16 school projects with its partner organization Shanti Griha Nepal. In the project locations, which are often only accessible on foot, the children do not have the same educational opportunities as children in the cities.

A new school for the village of Kolar: In the village of Kolar, there is a small, dilapidated school. Children from kindergarten to fifth grade are taught here. However, because of the poor condition of the school, it is not possible to provide age-appropriate education. There is also a lack of teaching and learning materials. The construction of three new classrooms will increase the school's capacity. The new classrooms will be equipped with teaching and learning materials. In addition, the hygiene situation will be improved by the construction of two toilets and the establishment of a water supply. Our project partner Shanti Griha will also offer a needs-based workshop program.

► **In total, 114 children will be able to attend school and more than 700 people will benefit from the training.**

UKRAINE

Since 2022, KHW has also been committed to helping people in the war-affected Ukraine. Our focus is on children and young people and their families, and we rely on our many years of experience in the field of medical donations in kind. In cooperation with the Capuchin Monastery in Münster, we supply the local civilian population with medical products and support two projects for internally displaced people in Ukraine.

In Bilyj Kamin, the KHW is supporting the opening of a family bakery and in Dnistryk in Western Ukraine, a dilapidated youth center is being renovated to provide young people with a safe space for social interaction and leisure activities.
